## ROLL OF HONOUR

### Forward ~ For God, King and Country.

The first known record of a Roll of Honour compiled for The Royal Guernsey Light Infantry was submitted to the Branch Records Office Guernsey on 12<sup>th</sup> December 1919 by Major Roper. This roll consisted of Men (ordinary soldiers) and NCO's (non-commissioned Officers). No Roll of Honour of Commissioned Officers was made at that time. This official roll specifically concerned itself with those men who had enlisted from within the Bailiwick of Guernsey including men from Alderney and Sark. The roll was known as the List of Fallen Soldiers of the Royal Guernsey Light Infantry. It was specific to the period and so omitted those who joined later from other Army units, and from other areas such as England, Scotland, Wales and Jersey. Neither did it include later enlistments from the Bailiwick of Guernsey. One significant omission was the drafts enrolled from the 2<sup>nd</sup> (Home Service) Garrison Battalion of the North Staffordshire Regiment. During August 1917 they later formed into the 17<sup>th</sup> Battalion of the Royal Defence Corps, men were transferred from either into the R.G.L.I.

A centenary later, far more is now known about the Bailiwick of Guernsey's named Regiment, and of the men who served with the 1<sup>st</sup> (Service) Battalion or 2<sup>nd</sup> (Reserve) Battalion during the Great War. This new Centenary Roll of Honour; is a more inclusive roll covering all those who fell as either serving members or former members of the R.G.L.I. It also includes those who died later as a result of injuries or illness caused or exacerbated by active service during the Great War.

In addition, this roll includes those known to have died while serving with other regiments and units during the Great War, having previously served with the Royal Guernsey Light Infantry. The roll covers the period up to and including 11<sup>th</sup> November 1922. This date is a few months later than that chosen by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission but has been chosen because it includes Lieutenant Frank de Moulpied LAINÉ M.C. He distinguished himself earning the Military Cross for his service with the 1<sup>st</sup> Bn., Royal Guernsey Light Infantry but died of wounds on 7<sup>th</sup> October 1922.

**R.G.L.I. Militia note:** During the earlier war period before the formation of the R.G.L.I. (4<sup>th</sup> August 1914 – 16<sup>th</sup> December 1916) there were two known fatalities that are commemorated by the CWGC. They are also remembered and honoured for their service within this roll.

The new Service and Reserve Battalions of the Royal Guernsey Light Infantry were officially formed on the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1916 in part response to the Billet d'État 1915.

R.G.L.I. Militia Officers were granted a temporary commission within the British Army and the soldiers were enlisted with new regimental service numbers as they joined the 1<sup>st</sup> Service or 2<sup>nd</sup> Reserve Battalions of the Royal Guernsey Light Infantry.


