grave in the cemetery mentioned, and the matter was
thereupon taken up with the Imperial War Graves
Commission who advise that according to their records,
Pte. Davey was buried at map reference 62d.E.9.c.1.3.,
which is about 1 mile North of the village of
Dernancourt.

Dernancourt Communal Cemetery Extension
contains a large number of Unknown members of the
A.I.F. whose remains were exhumed round that area,
and the Imperial War Graves Commission have advised that
after full investigation of the matter, they consider
that the circumstances justify the erection in that
Cemetery of a Special Cross to the above-named soldier,
reading "Believed to be buried in this Cemetery",
and that necessary instructions have been issued
accordingly.

Necessary action is being taken at this end
to advise the next of kin of the erection of the
Special Cross referred to.




