Dear Madam,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your communication of 4th July, 1938, relative to the affairs of the late No. 3227 Private James Parsons MURCHY, 32nd ex 27th Battalion, and the late No. 1744A Private James Thomas MURCHY, 32nd ex 27th Battalion, Australian Imperial Force, and in reply to inform you that, according to the records, the firstnamed soldier embarked from Australia on 12th January, 1916, and was reported Killed in Action on 19th July, 1916, whilst the latter embarked on 23rd June, 1915, and was Killed in Action on 20th July, 1916.

It is noted in the case of James Parsons Murphy that he is stated to have executed a Will naming Mr. F.A. Morgan as Executor, and it is suggested that further particulars regarding the same may be obtained on application to the District Pinance Officer, Keswick Barracks, Keswick, South Australia.

No record is held at this office, however, of the late James Thomas Murphy having executed a Will whilst a member of the Australian Imperial Force, and it is understood that his estate was administered by the Public Trustee, Adelaide.


