With reference to the regrettable report of death of your son, the late No. 7316 Private P.J. Pinel, 47th Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice that he was wounded in action on 27th March, 1918, in France, and admitted to the 13th Australian Field Ambulance, suffering from Gunshot Wound Shoulder, Penetrating Thorax. He was transferred to the 3rd Canadian Stationary Hospital on 28th March, 1918, but succumbed to his wounds before being admitted. He was buried at Douellens, France.

The utmost care and attention is being devoted, where possible, to the graves of our soldiers. It is understood that photographs are being taken as soon as is possible, and these will be transmitted to next-of-kin when available.

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with the deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.


