Service: Soldat 149eRI (Regiment d'Infanterie)

Matricule au recrutement #1701 Annecy (Haute-Savoie) Class 1904

Classified as auxiliary service, recognized as suitable for armed service (14 Nov1914 in Dover) and assigned to the 97th RI which he joined on 6 Dec1914, passed to the 17th RI on 2 Feb1915, then to the 149th RI on13 Mar1915 when he left for the front

Awards: Medaille Militaire (posthumue) 5 Oct 1920 Croix de guere (with bronze star and palm)

Citation: "During the night combat of May 29, 1915, isolated with some comrades under heavy machine gun fire, urged them to continue to fire. Hit and died by a bullet to the head, was found lying in the position of the gunner, the weapon still supported"

Died: KIA 29 May 1915 Aix-Noulette, Pas-de-Calais

Grave: Carre Militaire Franco-Britannique, Aix-Noulette, Pas De Calais Row 14, grave 261
