1st Class Enseigne de Vaisseau to Marine Fusiliers (3rd Company)
The Marine Rifle Battalion, which came out of the Disbanded Brigade in November 1915, consisted of four rifle companies and a machine gun company, with a strength of 1,100 men. In 1916 he operated on the Flanders front near Nieuport and occupied Saint-Georges, a remote village in the middle of the flooded polder waters and a strong point of defence. From 17 to 18 May 1916, the positions north of Saint-Georges, along the Yser, were shelled by heavy bombardment of all artillery calibers (57, 77, 210) and large bombs. Every ten minutes, a gunshot fired at St. George's hose north. During the night, bursts at close intervals targeted stations 4 to 8 of the hose. In West Flanders, on the outskirts of Nieuport, fighting continued throughout 1917. The ship's ensign d'Aboville, was seriously injured in action, on the 5 March 1917. He was evacuated to La Panne Hospital, where he died on 27 March, 1917 from his wounds.

Awards: Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur

Citation: To the Order of the Army: "Officer most distinguished, full of energy and bravery, who came to the front at his request, on March 5, 1917, seeing one of our outposts beaten by enemy bombs, went there spontaneously to lead the response. Was seriously injured during the action."

Died: Died of wounds 27 March 1917– La Panne Hospital, Nieuport, Belgique,

Grave: Unknown
