Voluntarily enlisted at Recruitment office Tours #1501 Class 1915
Initially at the 21e RD (Regiment de Dragons), then appointed aspirant at the 14e RH (Regiment de Hussards)

Awards: Military medal (posthumous), Croix de guerre (star)

Citation: "On the night of March 28-29, 1917, being on patrol in front of the front-line trench, was fatally struck by shrapnel from a grenade. Very brave aspirant, having a high conception of his duty." translated

Died: Died of wounds 29 Mar 1917 in the Trenches in Centaures District, Rambluzin-et-Benoite-Vaux, Meuse

Grave: Unknown
