Service: Sous-Lieutenant 4e RMZ (Regiment de Marche de Zouaves)

Matricule recruitment # 452, Seine 2e bureau, Class 1914

Engaged voluntarily 28 Nov 1914 in Paris 7e for the 8e RCC at Orleans.

Appointed sergeant, then house marshal. Left for the front May 1915.

Appointed Brigadier 20 July 1915.

Cadet Officer Saint-Cyr 1 Mar - 31 Jul 1916.

Appointed Aspirant 1 Aug 1916 and assigned to the 13^e RH.

Requested transfer to the Infantry and assigned to the 4^e RZ - refused to join the divisional Depot and went to the front 4 Aug 1917 as a Liaison Officer ahead of the Brigade. Was appointed sous-lieutenant.

Seriously injured 23 Oct 1917 during the attack on Fort de la Malmaison in Chavignon. Right leg amputation in hospital.

Transferred to Hospital in Paris from 2 Dec 1917 but developed tetanus 11 Dec and died on the 13 Dec.

Awards: Croix de guerre (palme et étoile)
