Born: 22 Aug 1874 Savennieres, Maine-et-Loire

Jesuit Priest ordained 24 Aug 1904. Studied in England and Jersey and was a teacher of sciences at Saint François de Sales, Evraux and the College at Marneffe in Belgium.

Service: Caporal 272e RI (Regiment d'Infanterie)

Matricule au recruitment: #28 Angers, Class 1894

Recalled in Aug 1914 to the 71e R.I.T.

Passed to 272nd R.I.T. 12 Aug 1914 4e Bataillon, 13e Compagnie

Argonne (Jan 1915) and Champagne (Oct 1915).

The trench in front of Tahure where his company was located Oct 1915 was heavily bombarded by the Germans and destroyed on 9 Oct 1915. He was reported missing and presumed killed in action; his body was never found.

As an ordained priest he probably served in a less combatant role such as a volunteer stretcher bearer.

Death: MIA/KIA 8 Oct 1915 Sommepy Tahure, Marne

Memorial: Remembered on the Commemorative plaque at Saint Francois de Sales, Evreux and on the Ossuary monument at the farm at Navarin Souain-

Perthes-lès-Hurlus that lists the soldiers missing in the Souain Sector. He should have been remembered on the War Memorial at Savennieres, Maine-et-Loire but his name was not included (probably due to his father being deceased and no one followed it up).




